




IB Diploma Provisional Results for 2016

The seven ESF secondary schools (including Discovery College and Renaissance College) entered a total of 956 students for the IB Diploma in May 2016 and we are extremely proud to announce another set of excellent results.

99% of students have been awarded the full IB Diploma (of those who were entered for it) and the mean number of IB points per student is 36.1 points, the highest ever for the ESF. Both figures compare favourably against the worldwide IB averages of 80.8% and 30.1 points respectively.

24.7% of students achieved 40 or more IB points, 64.3% of students achieved 35 or more points and 91.3% of students 30 or more points. Seven ESF students achieved the maximum possible score of 45 IB points (the IBO announced on results day that only 146 students worldwide had achieved this accolade). One hundred and twelve ESF students also achieved the prestigious Bilingual Diploma qualification. [A Bilingual Diploma is achieved when students study two languages at native or near native level.] However, many success stories also involve those students who at times struggled with the rigour and intensity of the IB Diploma but persevered and ultimately achieved their goals.



ESF wishes to congratulate all students who have achieved success and acknowledge the excellent support given to them by their teachers throughout their ESF education. Over the summer, schools will be actively supporting those students who may not as yet have secured a higher education place based on their achievements.

Please note: These are preliminary data. A few results are missing and this data does not yet reflect the outcomes of any appeals that may be made regarding individual students and subjects.
